Rules for 100 Club

1. NAME: The name of the club shall be there "KESCRG 100 Club" ("the club")
2. OBJECT: The object of the club shall be to raise funds for KESCRG (Kent and East Sussex Canal Restoration Group). ("the group").
3. MEMBERSHIP: Membership of the club shall be limited to 100 persons, each member must be over eighteen years old. Each membership shall fund of period of twelve months.
4. TRUSTEES: The club shall be administered by three trustees appointed annually by the officers of the group. The trustees shall elect a treasurer from amongst their number to be responsible for the keeping of accounts arranging payment of prizes and the transfer of surplus income to the group. The decision of the trustees in any matter relating to the operation of the club shall be final.
5. SUBSCRIPTIONS: The annual subscription to the club shall be £10 (ten pounds) payable on admission to the club. The subscription may be paid by cheque or bankers standing order. A member may hold more than one membership of the club.
6. PRIZES: A draw shall take place on each weekend working party or other occasion as directed by the trustees but not less than six times in one year. There shall be a maximum of two prizes awarded in each draw, both for £20 (twenty pounds) with the exception of the last draw of the year when two additional prizes for £50 (fifty pounds) and £25 (twenty-five pounds) respectively shall be awarded.
Each draw shall be made by or under the direction of the trustees. The results of each draw shall be announced in the next copy of the groups newsletter.
Prizewinners shall be notified in writing of their entitlement to receive a prize and payment will be made by cheque posted to the address shown on the membership application form or to such other address as the member may have subsequently notified the trustees.
In the event that the membership of the club is less than 100 members in any year the trustees shall be entitled to reduce the amounts of prizes or the number of draws or both providing that in these circumstances the ratio of the prize money to subscription is not affected.
7. ACCOUNTS: The accounts of the club shall be kept by the treasurer and shall be audited annually by the group's auditor. The treasurer shall keep a roll of membership and each member shall be allocated a roll number.
