100 Club Rules for KESCRG 100 Club

1. NAME: The name of the club shall be there “KESCRG 100 Club” (“the club”)
2. OBJECT: The object of the club shall be to raise funds for KESCRG “the group”.

KESCRG is a registered charity (1165205) that promotes the restoration, conservation, maintenance and protection of canals and waterways within the UK for the use and benefit of the public in particular but not exclusively through the provision of work parties and voluntary labour to undertake physical restoration and maintenance in conjunction with waterways societies and other organisations.

3. MEMBERSHIP: Membership of the club shall be limited to 100 persons, each member must be over eighteen years old. Each membership shall fund of period of twelve months.

4. ADMINISTRATION: The club shall be administered by an individual appointed annually by the trustees of the group. They will be responsible for the keeping of accounts, arranging payment of prizes and the transfer of surplus income to the group.

5. SUBSCRIPTIONS: The annual subscription to the club shall be £10 (ten pounds) payable on admission to the club. The subscription may be paid by cheque, cash or standing order. A member may hold more than one membership of the club.

6. PRIZES: Ten draws shall take place throughout the year. Draws will coincide with weekend working parties. Each draw shall be made by or under the direction of the administrator.

There shall eight draws for prizes of £20 (twenty pounds) with the exception of the last two draws of the year which will be for prizes of £25 (twenty-five pounds) and £50 (fifty pounds) respectively.

In the event that the membership of the club is less than 100 members in any year the trustees shall be entitled to reduce the amounts of prizes or the number of draws or both providing that in these circumstances the ratio of the prize money to subscription is not affected. A minimum of six draws will take place throughout the year.

The results of each draw shall be posted on the group’s facebook page and published on the group’s website.

Prizewinners shall be notified in writing of their entitlement to receive a prize and payment will be made by cheque posted to the address shown on the membership application form or to such other address as the member may have subsequently notified the administrator.

7. ACCOUNTS: The accounts of the club shall be kept by the administrator and shall be presented annually to the group’s trustees. The administrator shall keep a register of membership and each member shall be allocated a share number.
